

Achievement Awards

The Achievement Awards program was established many years ago. I'm not sure when but I know it was prior to the early 1970s. What the program was designed to do is to give a chapter an opportunity to be recognized for the various achievements it had accomplished -- singing, administration, outreach, etc. Plaques and certificates are presented to all participating chapters. This is done at the same three plateau levels that are used for chorus contests. First, second and third place awards are given to the top three chapters in each plateau (Note: Plateau AAA only has three chapters total). Honorable mention awards are presented to those chapters in Plateau AA achieving a minimum of 1000 points and to those chapters in Plateau A achieving a minimum of 750 points. All other chapters receive Participation Awards.
